Welcome back everyone to Term 3. We have started off the term with a hiss and a roar at school. Our students have come back to school ready to learn which is fantastic. Over the course of the term, we have many exciting events for the students to look forward to. The students first major piece of learning is with our community police officer Kevin Marshall who is assisting the staff in taking the students through the Keeping Ourselves Safe programme. This is a programme schools generally carry out every two years and is important for students to learn about relationships. Moananui and Papakura go more indepth about healthy relationships and who to talk to if they are concerned.

Our new build is almost at completion. The multipurpose space/library is 99% completed and we are just waiting for everything to be signed off. The staff will be brainstorming this week an appropriate way to open this new block. Some furniture for the library is already on its way so hopefully we will be able to start moving in late next month. Further to that property news, we have finally had sign off for the redesign of our new front entrance into school. This is part of the School Investment Package (SIP) that was announced at the end of 2019 and was a one-off funding package to help schools accelerate property works at school that they would otherwise be unable to afford. The new entrance will include a disability ramp and better access for emergency vehicles.

Once again, I would like to thank all those community members who have volunteered time, goods, or services for our school. I put out a quick message on our school app yesterday about borrowing a trailer and I received 2 responses within 5 minutes with a further 3 people offering up to the point of writing this. We, as a school community, are trying to make Meeanee School the best place for our students which includes making sure that our grounds are fit for purpose. I would like to also make special mention to the people at Coffee Bliss and Midland Horticulture, who are local businesses who are supporting us.



Papakura (Room 3) currently has a pie fundraiser underway to raise funds to reduce camp fees. In this newsletter you can find out more information about that. Finally, I also want to remind you about the PTA's Quiz Night on Friday 10th September, which will be held at the Meeanee Pub.


