#### **Uniform Policy**

The Board of Trustees has just reviewed our uniform policy, which is below. If you have any questions please email or phone the office.

- School hat must be worn in Terms 1 & 4
- School Polar fleece only or Kidscan jacket can be worn on cold or wet mornings.
- School Polo top only. A long sleeved black thermal or t-shirt may be worn underneath but it must be black.
- Black trackpants, skorts, shorts, leggings, skirts must be plain black with no writing on them. No denim.
- Plain black socks or tights.
- Suitable shoes for physical activity. Junior classes to only wear shoes they can put on themselves. Children must arrive and leave school with shoes on. No jandals.
- No makeup, no dangly earrings or other jewellery except for pounamu or other cultural/religious items of significance. To be worn under clothing.
- Natural hair colour and long hair below shoulder must be tied up for health and safety reasons.

## Impetigo—School sores

We have had a couple of cases of School Sores (Impetigo) in our Junior school. These present as blisters with a yellow crust which are normally itchy on the face, hands and legs.

If suspected please make an appointment to see your GP and keep your children

away from school until the sores are completely dry and are not weeping anymore. Your GP will prescribe an antibiotic and a full course must be taken before your child returns to school. School sores are easily passed between adults and children so good hygiene (regular hand washing, washing all bedding and clothing) is important as well as discouraging scratching and touching the affected areas to decrease the risk of spreading them.
