On Monday we have a teacher only day. This day provides us the opportunity to meet with all our staff — teachers, teacher aides, and office administrator to look at our Positive Behaviour for Learning Professional Development. Although we scored highly in our initial assessment from the Ministry of Education there are always areas to work on. For the first half of the day, we will be looking at our schoolwide values and how we promote these in our school, what our expectations are across the school, and the functions of behaviour. In the afternoon, the teachers will remain and work on our school Maths curriculum. Our School App is becoming more prominent for our communication. We now have 87 users of the app, which is pleasing, and we only have a few people now who have not signed up with their email and password. Doing this means that we can send you an individual message if necessary, and you do not need to be on Facebook to receive important messages.
